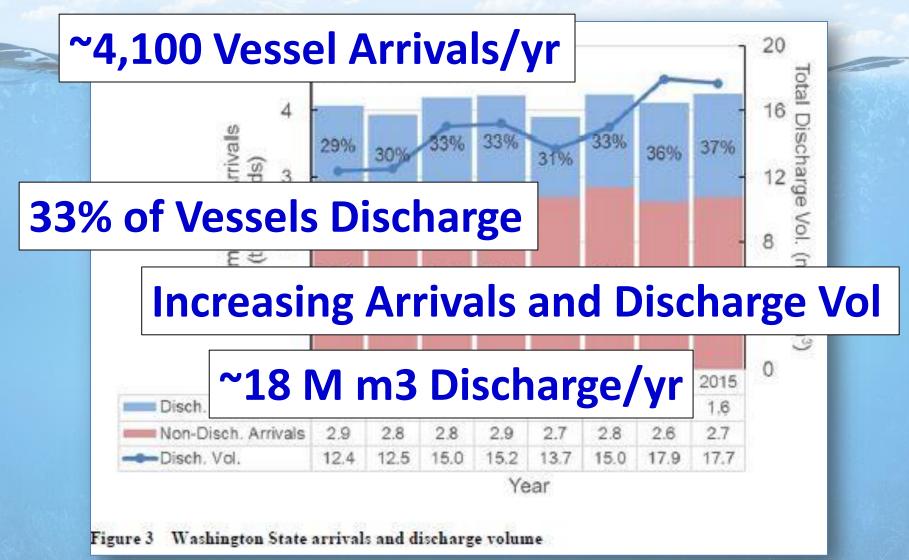


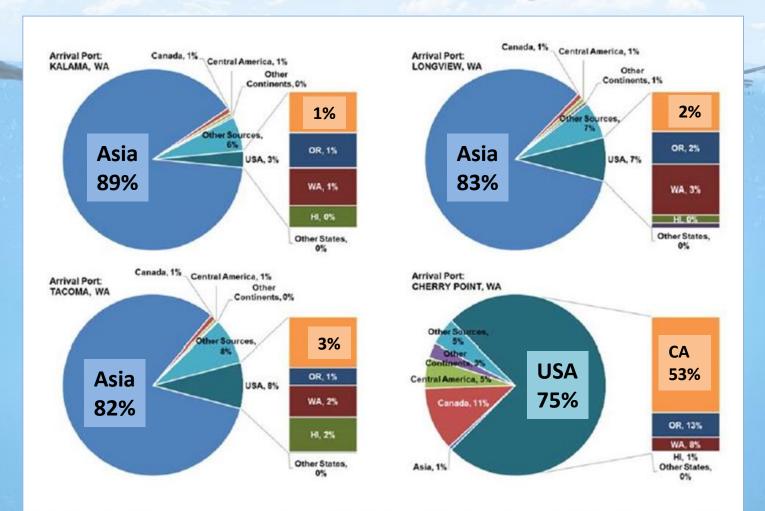
Washington State Mission

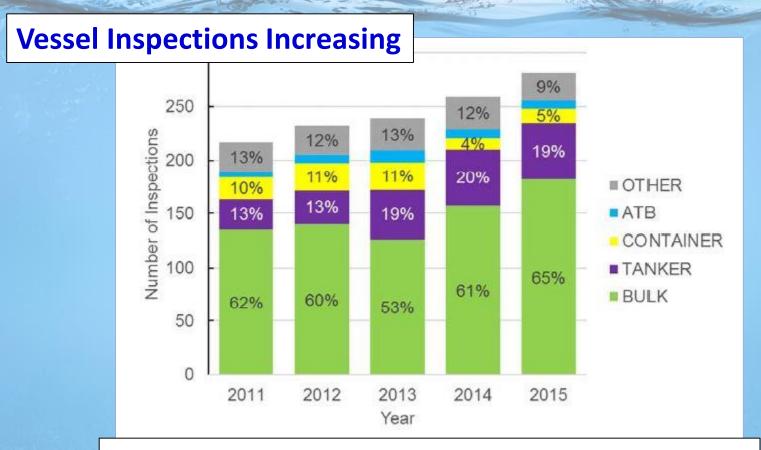

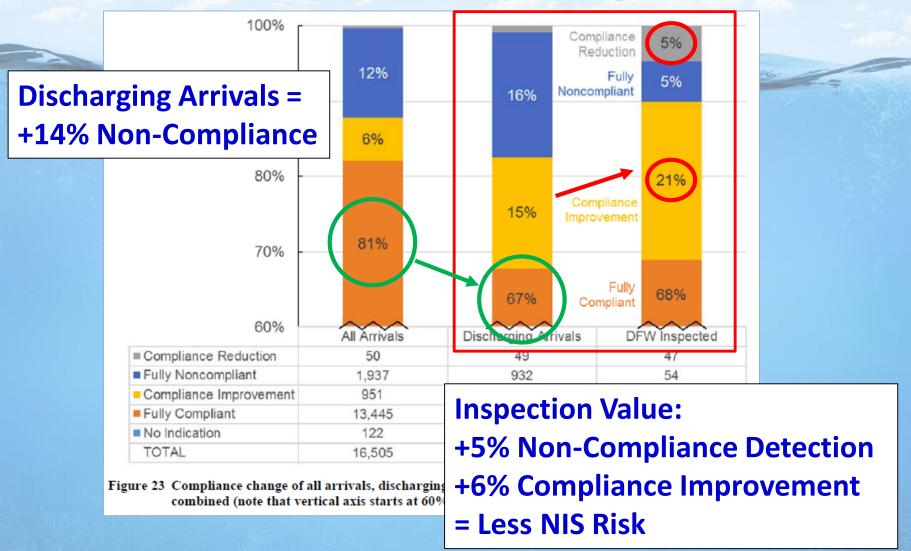




Port risks can vary by discharge volume and ballast water source



Inspections by Vessel Type Relatively Consistent



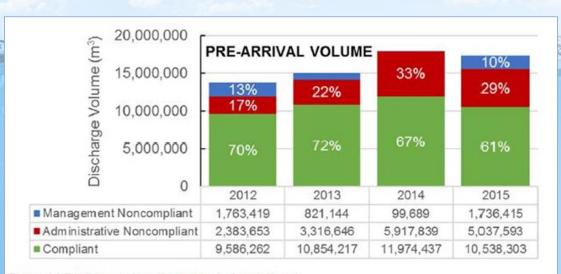


Figure 26 Discharge volume by pre-arrival compliance

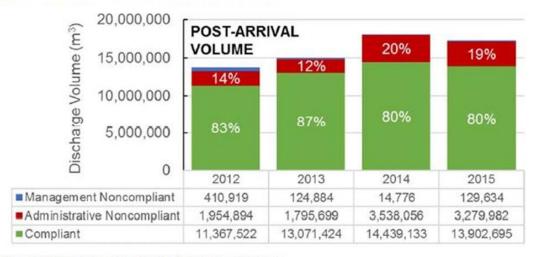


Figure 27 Discharge volume by post-arrival compliance
