
Hybrid vessel inspection

- Inspection conducted at gangway
 - Document request
 - Inspector reviews documentation in their vehicle
- Final communications can be handled via email
- Not possible at all ports



Adapting to change

- Port safety concerns differ based on multiple factors
 - Accessibility
 - Security requirements
- Adaptation depends on inspector knowledge
